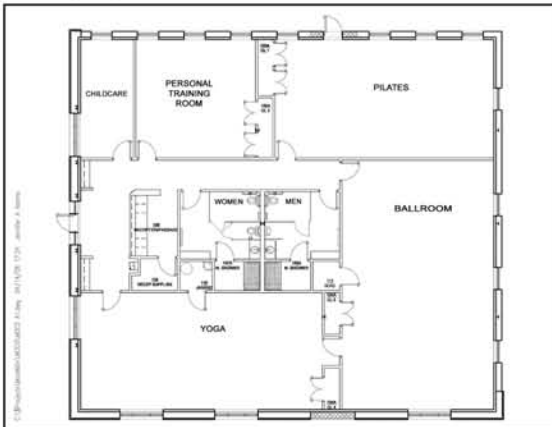

Moving Forward

As you've heard, we will be relocating our adult programs to our new **MoCo Arts on Elm** located in the MacMillin complex on Elm Street, behind ArtWorks. Construction is well underway and the floors, lighting and colors have been carefully selected to provide a welcoming and inspiring atmosphere for our students. This exciting new Annex will include a state-of-the-art Pilates Studio, two multi-purpose general fitness studios, a personal training room and a child care room. Watch for developing news about how this wonderful new space is being adapted for our multi-arts and wellness programs.



Our original headquarters at 76 Railroad Street will also undergo some changes. We already have installed a beautiful new sign, generously donated by Don Healy, proclaiming our identity as *MoCo Arts*. In addition, a recent grant from Timken will fund roof repairs and upgrading of our building's heating and cooling system. This summer we will create a second "Black Box Theatre" at this site for use by our Summer Camps (CAKE) in July. This conversion will give our students more opportunity to learn technical theatre skills as well as provide additional on-site rehearsal and performance space.
