Journey with MoCo Arts Students from Narnia to the Chocolate Factory



Keene, NH - Tickets to two MoCo Arts Middle School Theatre productions are now on sale and include two extremely exciting performances by some very talented students. The Middle School Play, *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, will be performed in *The Founder's Theatre* at MoCo Arts on December 2nd at 1:00pm and 4:00pm. Then on the following Sunday, December 9th, The Middle School Musical Theatre students will perform *Roald Dahl's Willy Wonka JR*. with performances at 1:00pm and 4:00pm, also in *The Founder's Theatre*.



This new dramatization of C.S.
