MoCo Arts Teens Musical Theatre Performs Emotional Classic 'Les Misérables School Edition'

(Keene, NH) — MoCo Arts Teens Musical Theatre proudly presents the classic musical Les Misérables School Edition on Friday, May 18 at 7:00pm and Saturday, May 19 at 2:00pm at the Redfern Arts Center at Keene State College.

It's nineteenth century France and Jean Valjean has been released from years of unjust imprisonment. In search of starting a new life he is faced with nothing but mistrust and mistreatment. He becomes relentlessly pursued by police inspector Javert, who refuses to believe Valjean can change his ways. Javert must confront his ideals during the Paris student uprising of 1832 when Valjean spares his life.

'Les Misérables School Edition will bring the audience on a journey,' says Hannah Lambert, a Sophomore at Conant High School playing the important role of Cosette. "It pulls you into the life of a man who has been broken, you can't help but feel the suffering of the time. But, you also see a better side of life and a young love that grows and develops. You get to watch two people fall in love which is a beautiful thing."

Epic, grand and uplifting, *Les Misérables School Edition* features powerful and iconic musical numbers like 'One Day More' and 'I Dreamed A Dream' that have thrilled audiences all over the world. The School Edition has been shortened to a running time of just over two hours. There are some mature topics and language.



"Being a part of a MoCo Arts musical is unlike anything I have ever done," says Lambert. "The sense of community and friendship shared here is so unreal. MoCo truly puts on an incredible show, and also teaches us as we go. I'm not sure where I'd be without MoCo."
