(Keene, NH) –Approximately 600 enthusiastic guests gathered Tuesday night behind MoCo Arts' new arts education facility at 40 Roxbury Street awaiting the highly-anticipated Ribbon Cutting and Open House ceremony. After brief speeches from organization and community leaders, beautiful singing from a group of MoCo Theatre students, three Keene High School seniors – representing all the MoCo 12th graders – came up to the microphone to announce they had come together to make a gift of \$500.00. The \$500.00 put the 'MoCo Moves: Building MoCo Arts' Future' capital campaign over the \$5 million fundraising goal!

The appreciative crowd erupted in cheers, awestruck at the reality that this goal had been reached. In true MoCo spirit, it was teamwork, perseverance, and dedication that made this project possible.
