Explore the Arts, Make Friends, and Have Fun This Summer at MoCo Arts



(Keene, NH) – It's not too early to start planning your summer at MoCo Arts. Children of all ages can experience the arts, make friends, and have fun in MoCo's popular multi-arts summer day camps. Registration is now open, register by visiting or calling MoCo Arts at 603-357-2100.

C.A.K.E. (Creative Arts at Keene) Summer Camp is a fun and unique multi-arts summer camp that *transforms lives*. Students going into 2nd – 12th grade experience the joy of the arts by choosing their own classes in theatre, visual art, music, dance, video production, technical theatre, creative writing and more; molding their own personal camp experience. Performance opportunities are available too, for those who wish to perform. C.A.K.E. runs July 2 – 27, students can register for 1, 2, 3 or all 4 weeks of camp (half-day options are also available). Tuition to C.A.K.E. is \$225 per week, with additional aftercare until 5:00pm for \$12 per day. An Early Bird Special Discount is available for students who register for all four weeks of C.A.K.E. on or before May 1.

CupCAKE Multi-Arts Summer Camps provide a fun and safe introduction to the performing and creative arts for our youngest campers ages 4 years through 2nd grade. This summer features 4 weeks of camps that challenge campers to use their imagination, think outside of the box, play with slime, and become a mad scientist. Each week of camp features singing, dancing, and creative art projects with a musical theatre performance at the end of the week. Week 1: 'True Colors' (June 25 – 29), rainbow inspired art, music, dance, and fun. Week 2: 'Out of the Box' (July 30 – August 3), uses creativity and imagination to build a cardboard city. Week 3: 'Ooey, Gooney' (August 6 – 10), filled with slimey, gloopy, gloppy fun. Week 4: 'Kaboom! A Musical Mad Science Revue' (August 13 – 17), meets a mad scientist who loves to sing, dance, and do science experiments. Register for 1, 2, 3 or all 4 weeks of CupCAKE Camps. Tuition is \$215 per week, with early drop off and aftercare available until 5:00pm for \$12 per day.

Tuition Assistance is available for all MoCo Arts summer camps, assistance is awarded based on the financial need of each applicant. Applying is easy, visit www.moco.org to download an application, or pick one up at our front desk. Tuition Assistance applications for summer camps are due May 15.
