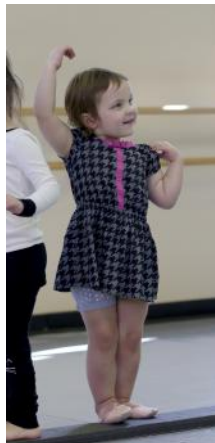

Dance is for *everybody* and this summer **MoCo's School of Dance** offers dance classes for everyone regardless of age or ability, beginner through advanced. Participate in ballet, tap, jazz, hip hop, and modern dance.

**MoCo's Theatre Program** offers two engaging Theatre Workshops this summer: *Improvisation*, ideal for kids 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade, and *Storybook Adventures*, ideal for kids 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>. Each workshop gives students both new and experienced the chance to explore concepts of theatre through fun and engaging games.

For the youngest students, **MoCo's Young Arts Program** offers Creative Dance this summer for children starting at 3 years old. Creative Dance introduces children to the fundamentals of dance while honoring their own creative way of moving.
