MoCo Arts Concludes 2019 Performance Season with the Storytime Theatre production of 'Rainbow Fish'



KEENE, NH -- MoCo Arts' Storytime Theatre will present their spring production of *Rainbow Fish* on Saturday, June 15th at 2pm and 4pm in *The Founder's Theatre* at MoCo Arts, 40 Roxbury Street in Keene. The production marks the end of an exciting first season in MoCo's new black box theatre.

The *Rainbow Fish* has all sorts of colors - blue, green, purple and silver. One day a small fish asks if he can have one of the precious silver scales, but the *Rainbow Fish* refuses in a very rude manner. The *Rainbow Fish* must learn to share his beauty with his friends, or he may not continue to be so beautiful.

Storytime Theatre is MoCo's musical theatre class for children ages 4 years through 2nd grade. Students in this class learn and produce a 45-minute theatrical presentation featuring acting, singing, dancing, costumes and sets. Every child enrolled in the class is cast in a role and has the opportunity to perform. Registration for the fall semester of Storytime Theatre opens July 2nd.

A fun, family-friendly musical, *Rainbow Fish* is performed by MoCo Arts students 4yrs – 2nd grade.
